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Preface

The history of Iran can be traced back to several millenniums BC. This ancient land has a rich culture that has not only influenced the Middle East but has left its impact other parts of the world as well.

The rich Iranian culture became profounder with the embracement of Islam by the inhabitants of this territory, leading to the sublimation and promotion of the Iranian culture through interminglement of the Iranian and Islamic cultures.
